




The Virginia Critical Infrastructure Protection and Resiliency Strategic Plan (VCIPRSP)

- Developed by the Secure Commonwealth Panel, Critical Infrastructure Sub-Panel
- Focus is to enhance Critical Infrastructure / Key Resource (CI/KR) protection and resiliency to ensure that essential governmental missions, state services, and economic functions are maintained in the event of a terrorist attack, natural disaster, or other type of significant incident

- Identified agency roles and responsibilities

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



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National Framework for Homeland Security




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VCIPRSP Process

- Coordinating Draft will be circulated for review and comment by Cabinet
- CIP Sub-panel reviews and incorporates recommended changes
- Final document will be signed by the Governor and Cabinet Secretaries
- Living document – process for period review and improvement

VCIPRSP Implementation

- Cabinet Secretaries appoint Sector Leads for their respective sectors
- OCP chairs VCIPRSP Coordinating Council comprised of designated Sector Leads and others
- Implementation and rollout begins per the guidelines in the VCIPRSP
- **SCP CIP Sub-panel Staff / OCP Staff will provide guidance, assistance, and training**
- CIP Sub-panel will monitor implementation and report to the SCP




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Commonwealth Roles and Responsibilities
