







The SCP driving policy down through the Sub Panels to the CPWG


The CPWG driving policy up through the Sub Panels to the SCP

Sub Panel Purpose and Objectives



Purpose

Ensure that initiatives involving critical infrastructure and key resource protection and resiliency, information sharing, and outreach are coordinated amongst appropriate Federal, State, and local entities to ensure that resources are most efficiently applied for a more resilient and aware Commonwealth and its citizens.


Objectives

- Ensure a safer, more secure, and more resilient Virginia by enhancing the protection of the Commonwealth's Critical Infrastructure and Key Resources (CIKR) to prevent, deter, neutralize or mitigate the effects of natural or man caused events in conformance with the *National Infrastructure Protection Plan* (NIPP) and *Virginia Critical Infrastructure Protection and Resiliency Strategic Plan*.
- Promote and facilitate the sharing of information pertinent to safety and protection of the Commonwealth and its citizens by ensuring that information is shared amongst appropriate Federal, State, local, and private sector entities, both vertically and horizontally.
- Conduct activities so that citizens of the Commonwealth are informed of preparedness efforts; are provided the opportunity to provide input to first responders, private leaders, and public policy decision makers; and receive information on self preparedness.


Update of the Virginia Plan
