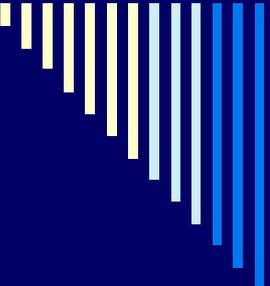




DHS GRANTS

- In 2008 DHS preparedness grant funds totaled over \$67 million
 - Programs are: Homeland Security Grants and Infrastructure Protection Grants

 - The National Capital Region received \$60 million

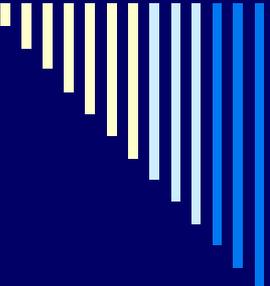
 - The Homeland Security Grant Program includes:
 - State Homeland Security, Citizen Corps Program, & Metropolitan Medical Response System
 - Urban Area Security Initiatives (Richmond Area, Hampton Roads, and the National Capital Region)

FY 08 DHS HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT

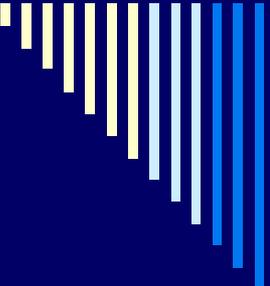
Funding Received \$24 million

- State Homeland Security Program - \$21,800,000
 - Hampton Roads Urban Area Security Initiative - \$7,760,000
 - Richmond Urban Area Security Initiative - \$1,721,500
 - Metropolitan Medical Response System - \$1,927,326
 - Citizen Corps Program - \$331,501

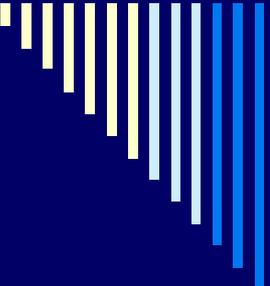
REGIONAL CATASTROPHIC PLANNING GRANT

- ❑ New Program in FY08 - Partnership between Virginia and North Carolina to address planning needs.
 - ❑ Virginia lead.
 - ❑ FY 2008, Hampton Roads received \$4.3 million.
 - ❑ In FY 2009, Hampton Roads will receive \$1,420,875 in a non-competitive process.

FY 2009 PROCESS

- ❑ NEW: DHS provided States with a target allocation in 2009
 - ❑ December 2008: Seven regional stakeholder meetings were held. Projects were requested and submitted from the Regional Preparedness Advisory Committees (RPAC)
 - ❑ March 2009: Grant Application written and submitted
 - ❑ July/August 2009: Award announced
 - ❑ September 2009: Funds will be distributed to sub-recipients

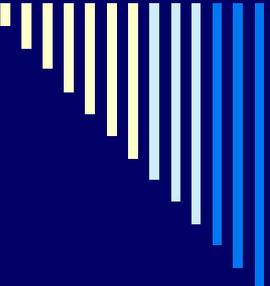

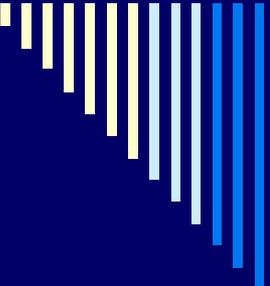

 - Statewide Interoperability Communications

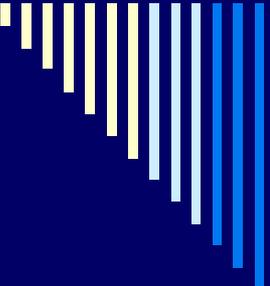
