







The SCP driving policy down through the Sub Panels to the CPWG


The CPWG driving policy up through the Sub Panels to the SCP

Objectives


- Ensure that First responders within the Commonwealth, both government and private, will be trained and equipped to respond to natural disasters and terrorist attacks using nationally accepted emergency management and response standards.
- Ensure that business within the Commonwealth have the requisite information, training, tools and established public-private partnerships to prepare for, mitigate respond to and recover from the effects of man caused or natural disasters.
- Ensure that the sheltering and evacuation needs of the citizens of the Commonwealth are met with appropriate levels of planning and response resulting from a coordinated effort between appropriate Federal, State, and local entities.


